Fill out the online form to create your student account. Then continue by following the online prompts to complete these fields: Personal Information, Educational Background & Interests, Academic Career and College, Requirements and Disclosures and ID Authentication.

When you get to the third prompt (Choose Academic Career and College), use the following options to complete these fields:

B. STUDENTS WITHOUT A STATE-ISSUED ID (Signed U.S. Passport **OR** High school ID **AND** birth certificate)

- Select SUBMIT AS E-FORM OR IN-PERSON •
- On the confirmation page, scroll down to "Next Steps" and select "Verify your Identity" or go to www.riosalado.edu/upload-photo-id to submit your forms of identification.
- Continue to Step 2 Submit Parent/Guardian Responsibility and Consent Form.

DETERMINE PLACEMENT

Rio Salado uses two processes to determine college course placement for students: unweighted high school GPAs and/or placement tests. To use high school GPA for placement (see chart in next column), students must have:

- Completed at least two years of high school coursework (i.e., Junior or Senior)
- Earned an unweighted, cumulative high school GPA of 2.6 or higher, based on a 4.0 scale

Students with 2.6–2.99 GPA are eligible to enroll in ENG101 and MAT142. Students with a GPA of 3.0 or higher are eligible to enroll in ENG101 and MAT15X or MAT187.

Students will need to take placement test if:

- They are currently a high school freshman/sophomore
- Their high school GPA is below 2.6, based on a 4.0 scale
- They wish to place in a higher level of English or Math www.maricopa.edu/testing
